Entries and Fees:

Checks payable to GAF: Members and non-members \$15

For one entry fee, artists may enter an unlimited number of fine art items and are allowed space for Gift Gallery, production-type items. Each person entering will be required to volunteer their time (two 4 hour shifts) working the show as hosts and salespeople. You may bring in new work to replace sold items. All items sold will be subject to a 20% sales commission.

Pre-registration is strongly encouraged. **Mail pre-registrations to Pam Ware, 7946 W 54th Ave, Arvada, CO 80002, by November 6.** This will help us determine the final number of volunteer hours required for participants.

Jurying:

Entries (including gift items) will be juried for cleanliness, craftsmanship and artistry. Entries made from published patterns will be accepted with written permission from the publisher.
